

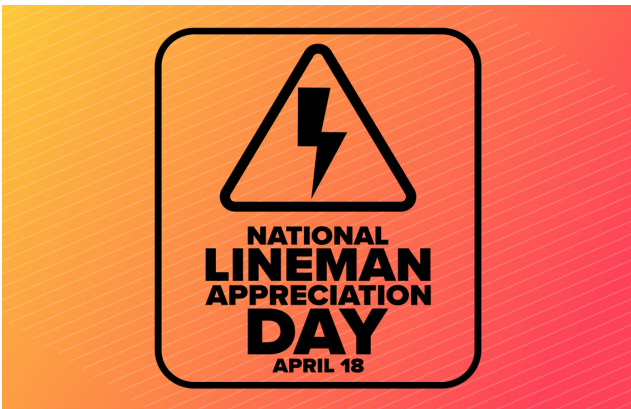
Potable vs. Non-Potable Water

Potable water is safe and acceptable for human consumption. Then what is non-potable water? Non-potable refers to any water that has not been treated or tested, therefore has not been determined to be unsafe for human consumption by state and federal standards.

In efforts to help conserve potable water HMU does have non-potable discharge water available for personal use. If you have the need for non-potable water please call our water plant at 733-0021 and they will schedule a time with you. You will need to supply the containers and transportation for your non-potable water.

We are still asking residents that have a personal swimming pool, hot tub, or other recreational structure that needs filled, to please call HMU at 733-0021 and schedule a time for filling your structure.

Reminder that HMU has a 'Water Watch' in effect from April 1, 2022, through September 30, 2022. 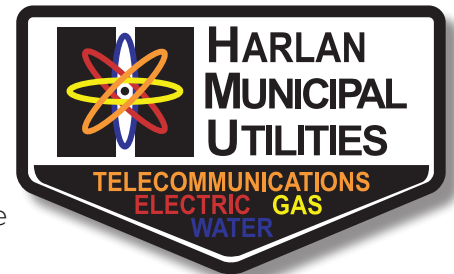
Now is the time to enroll in budget billing and level out your monthly payments over the next year. Please call us for details.
