

Resolution No. 67-2025
Approving Telephone Service Rates (Changes and/or Additions)

Harlan Municipal Utilities Board of Trustees took up and considered approval of Resolution Approving & Reaffirming Telephone Service Rates

Trustee Lucke introduced the following resolution entitled, “Approving Telephone Service Rates (Changes and/or Additions)”, and moved its adoption. The Trustee further moved that the Board Secretary is authorized and directed to publish notice of the aforementioned resolution to approve said rate change in the Harlan Newspaper, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Harlan, Iowa, as provided by Section 362.3, Code of Iowa. The Trustee further moved that the Board of Trustees waive the requirement of consideration of vote on the passage of this resolution at the next two board meetings prior to the passage of the final resolution. The resolution as recited is seconded by Trustee Ickes. After due consideration of the proposed resolution, the Chairman put the question on the motion to pass the resolution to a vote and the roll being called, the following board members voted.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF HARLAN MUNICIPAL UTILITIES:

Section 1: The telephone rates to be charged by Harlan Municipal Utilities, are as follows:

FCC Subscriber Line Charge Any further increase or decreases in the telephone Subscriber Line Charge as mandated by the FCC shall be automatically passed on to all telephone customers without further action by the Board of Trustees of Harlan Municipal Utilities	\$6.50/mo
Trunk Digital input/output (DIO) 24 channels	\$403.20/mo
Integrated Services Digital Network Access Charge (ISDN)	\$168.00/mo
Additional Directory Listings and Non-Published/Non-Listed Number	\$2.48/mo
ISDN PRI Line Port	\$23.51/mo
24 Hour Battery Backup Phone ONT	\$ 5.00/mo
Replacement of 24 Hour Battery Backup Phone ONT	\$160.00

Section 2: Repealer Clause. All resolutions, parts of resolutions, or service rules in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: HMU management shall have the authority without further board action or formal notice to customers to offer bundled rate packages of telephone services, cable TV, IPTV services and Internet services at lower rates than the total of individual rates, provided that the bundled rates shall not be less than the actual costs of delivery of each service.

Section 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this resolution shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective from and after the final passage, approval and publication as provided by law, with an effective date of July 1, 2025.
